BUSINESS HALL OF FAME 2023 INDUCTEES

With 131 individuals previously inducted, this ceremony continues its tradition of celebrating remarkable business achievements.

The criteria for nomination include 20 years of successful activity in a forprofit endeavor at a senior or ownership level, must live in Erie County, can be retired but still engaged in some fashion actively in the business (posthumous nominations may be considered), all industries and professional are eligible for the award.



James (Jim) Oram Wible is co-founder and long-time president of American Colors. His journey to success began in Pittsburgh, PA, where he graduated high school and received his Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Allegheny College. He then received his MBA from Xavier University in Cincinnati, and his career commenced at PPG Industries as a Sales Representative in Cincinnati and Detroit. At American Colors, he propelled the company to prominence, serving as President for 43 years before assuming the role of Chairman of the Board.
