## **Total Solar Eclipse**

On April 8, 2024, the moon will completely block out the sun for a rare total solar eclipse. Due to our global position directly in the path of totality, our communities in and around Shores & Islands Ohio will enjoy incredible, unobstructed viewing times of approximately four minutes—one of the longest durations in the entire region! The last total solar eclipse visible in Ohio was in 1806. The next total solar eclipse in Ohio will be in the year 2099.

Earlier this year, FirstEnergy implemented a new incentive program for commercial and industrial customers looking to install LED lighting and controls in their facilities. Although funds are limited, the program is available through May 31, 2024, for both existing buildings and new construction.

The program has incentives in place for LED fixtures, both interior and exterior, at \$0.05 per kWh saved. There are also dollars available for LED lamps, exit signs, and custom lighting.

There have been recent updates to the program that have added new tiered incentives for new applications.

Effective December 1st, receive additional incentives\* for any new application submitted when your project includes eligible lighting controls. Incentive level will vary based on level of control.

These additional incentives will be available until April 30th, but don't wait! Funds are limited. Fill out the request form at chamberenergyprogram.com for more information.

\*Pre-approved projects with signed offer letters do not qualify for the additional incentive.
